The Ohio Natural Energy Institute is proud to provide scholarships to students pursuing careers in the natural gas and oil industry. Each scholarship is worth \$1,500 per year with a total of four years of potential eligibility. The minimum scholarship applicant criteria include:

- Must be a U.S. citizen.
- Must have a career goal in the natural gas and oil industry.
- Must be an OHIO resident OR a student attending, or planning to attend, an accredited OHIO college, university, technical or trade school.
- Must have and maintain a grade point average (G.P.A.) of 2.5 or higher.

Hispanic Scholarship Fund

The HSF Scholarship is designed to assist students of Hispanic heritage obtain a college degree. Awards are based on merit; amounts range from \$500 to \$5,000, based on relative need, among the Scholars selected. Students must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale, and be a U.S. Citizen, Permanent Legal Resident, DACA, or Eligible Non-Citizen (as defined by FAFSA). As the nation's largest not-for-profit organization supporting Hispanic American higher education, HSF has awarded more than \$550 million in scholarships and provides a range of impactful programs for students, HSF scholars, alumni, and parents. The scholarship closes February 15.
